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Verification & Accreditation: the ongoing process

- Since September 2005 extensive work on capacity-building on verification and accreditation within the ETS compliance cycle
- Several meetings with MS & stakeholders
- 2 main policy projects: 2007 “Developing a More Coordinated Approach to Verification in the EU ETS” and 2008 “Draft Guidance Note”



Verification & Accreditation: the draft guidance note

- TWG formed to get agreement on elements strategic V&A Guidance
- TWG consists of 20 MS → four meetings were organized
- First meeting → agreement on non contentious issues from EA 6/03 and IETA verification protocol and identification of contentious issues
- On 8th of July agreement was reached on most of contentious issues elaborated on in XIII papers
- Next step is to prepare report which contains agreements on contentious issues and highlight non-contentious issues and process comments in paper
- Compliance Conference in September and Verification and Accreditation Forum in November



Agreement on non contentious issues (1)

- Roles and responsibilities parties EU ETS and need to create information feedback loops between those parties
- Verification process elements (pre-contract stage up to issuing VR)
- Relation risk assessment operator and risk analysis verifier practical tool to assess inherent and control risks
- Guidance on sampling and impact RA, magnitude risks on size sample
- Site visits
- Time allocation and practical use man day table under conditions
- Verification report template and need to create IT VR template



Agreement on non contentious issues (2)

- Elements accreditation process and need to set criteria for peer evaluation
- How to deal with misstatements and non-conformities during verification process and how to address these by operator
- Misstatements and non-conformities in VR and how to assess material effect
- Competence process and competence verifier incl role auditors and experts
- Independence and impartiality verifier
- Check timeliness, completeness and content AER and VR by CA (checklist)
- Possibility to officially determine emission figure if no or incorrect AER
- Free movement of verifier and need for conditions on mutual acceptance in line with services directive (i.e. supervision and notification)



Main contentious issues

- What information to exchange precisely between parties ETS
- Improvement and assessment man day table
- Criteria for waiving site visits
- Extent to which independent review can be waived for single verifiers and to which single verifiers will be allowed in future
- Common exams and competence requirements ISO 14066 compared to EA 6/03 requirements
- When and to what extent detailed review of AER and VR by CA
- Common conditions for mutual acceptance foreign verifiers
- How to officially determine emission figures and how to provide a framework for this in MRG and Directive
- Further elaboration of ISO 17011 in accreditation scheme
- Common competence requirements for accreditation assessors and peer evaluators (PE)
- development common exams and training for assessors/ PE
- Key performance indicators assessors/ verifiers and PE
- Criteria peer evaluation process



Strategic approach towards 2012

- Development report V&A guidance and papers
- Discuss work on verification and accreditation program
- Structure and planning for V&A forums (i.e. relation with Compliance Forum communication, involvement stakeholders)
- Work out issues identified as contentious and issues that need further action (i.e. checklists, verification templates etc.) → Compliance Forum
- Exchange information and best practices through forums and in ICAP context
- Make connection with IT development and include verification and accreditation (XETL etc.)
- Inclusion other sectors such as Aviation & CCS and assess impact on verification and accreditation
- Develop EU Commission verification and accreditation guidance for second trading period
- Involve non EA members and make transition to Accreditation Regulation easier



Third trading period after 2012

Article 15 revision EU ETS Directive Commission prerogative to draft Regulation on verification and accreditation

- Regulation direct effect which requires clear cut rules
- Main verification requirements, role CA in verification and mutual acceptance in V&A regulation
- Update Annex V EU ETS Directive required to provide correct legal basis
- Referral to Accreditation Regulation as the legal basis for EU ETS accreditation scheme
- Accreditation Regulation provides general framework which needs to be elaborated further
