Main objectives of TF AV

Objectives

- Share experiences on AV issues, collect views through surveys, create FAQs
- Provide input into Commission projects (e.g. input for regulations and guidances)
- Coordination with European Cooperation for accreditation

Main activities in 2023

- Sharing experiences on review of AERs/VRs and verification capacity
- Discussing the impact of fit for 55 package impact on A&V
- The EA shared regular updates on accreditation & surveillance
- Coordination between the TF aviation and TF AV on virtual site visits during verification in aviation sector

Summary of AV break out session

- Verification capacity will become more of an issue when implementing the fit for 55 package revisions in the MRR and AVR
 - Timely preparation and capacity building on the new topic helps. The EA will be organising trainings and meetings to prepare NABs
- Regulations and guidance need to be ready in time for the verifiers to prepare and carry out the verification and for accreditation bodies to assess verifiers
- It is important to develop effective tools to facilitate the work of all parties involved
 - Development of harmonised checklists to evaluate the performance of verifiers
- Participants indicated preference for topics to be addressed by the Task Force
 - The highest priorities were verification of biomass, ETS 2 verification and verifier's role in assessing energy efficiency recommendations
 - Other preferences included verification in maritime sector, CBAM, verfier capacity



Looking towards 2024

- Continue to share experiences, provide input in COM projects and coordinate with EA
- Need for prioritisation in topics to be addressed in the Task Force. Likely topics:
 - Verification of biomass and the role of the verifier
 - Verifier's role in assessing energy efficiency recommendations
 - Verification in ETS maritime
 - Experiences on the review of AERs and annual activity level data
 - Practical implementation issues
- Increased use of Sharepoint (e.g. recording common understanding, maintaining contact list, recording outputs of meeting)
