COMMISSION DECISION

of

on instructing the Central Administrator of the Community Independent Transaction Log to enter into the Community Independent Transaction Log the National Allocation Plan table of Luxembourg for the 2008-2012 period of the Community Emissions Trading Scheme

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EC) No 2216/2004 of 21 December for a standardised and secured system of registries pursuant to Directive 2003/87/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council and Decision No 280/2004/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council¹, and in particular Article 44 (1) thereof,

Whereas

(1) Luxembourg notified by letter dated 21 April 2008 its allocation decision for the 2008-2012 period taken under Article 11 of Directive 2003/87/EC and its national allocation plan table for the 2008-2012 period drawn up on the basis of Article 44 (1) of Commission Regulation (EC) No 2216/2004,

(2) The Commission finds that the notified national allocation plan table corresponds to the allocation decision and is based upon the national allocation plan notified by Luxembourg, as revised, without objections from the Commission, on the basis of Commission Decisions C/2006/5614 of 29 November 2006 and C/2007/3401 of 13 July 2007,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The Commission instructs the Central Administrator of the Community Independent Transaction Log to enter Luxembourg's National Allocation Plan table for the 2008-2012 period into the Community Independent Transaction Log in accordance with the initialisation procedures set out in Annex XIV of Commission Regulation (EC) No 2216/2004.
