### 1. COUNTRY HIGHLIGHTS


Nearly eight in ten respondents in Malta consider climate change to be a 'very serious' problem (79%, EU average 74%), an increase of 9 percentage points since the previous survey in 2015. The proportion who see it as the most serious problem facing the world (13%) is marginally above the EU average (12%).


Three-quarters of respondents (75%) say they have taken personal action to fight climate change in the past six months, notably above the EU average (49%). This proportion has increased by 17 pp since 2015 and is the second highest of all Member States. When given specific examples, the share rises to 94% (EU average 90%), suggesting that some do not associate certain actions with tackling climate change.

- Over eight in ten of those surveyed say they try to reduce waste and regularly separate it for recycling (83%, EU average 71%), while over two-thirds (68%) try to cut down on consumption of disposable items whenever possible (EU average 56%).
- More than half (54%) say they purchase locally produced and seasonal food whenever possible (EU average 41%).
- Respondents are also more likely than the EU average to consider lower energy consumption an important factor when buying a new household appliance (46%, EU average 37%).

Nine in ten respondents in Malta agree that more public financial support should be given to the transition to clean energies (90%, EU average 79%), while almost all believe it is important for their government to set targets to increase renewable energy use by 2030 (99%, EU average 89%) and provide support for improving energy efficiency by 2030 (97%, EU average 88%).




