


Ireland

- The Environmental Protection Agency is the Competent Authority for both Stationary and Aviation
- We have over 300 Aircraft Operators on our list
- 150 active in any given year
- 15-18 are required to report under 421/2014
- 5 Commercial Irish based aircraft operators and the balance are non commercial and based outside of Ireland
- Also the largest aircraft operator under 421/2014.

AEM Reviews

- While the Directive does not explicitly say that Competent Authorities must check AEM Reports, it is difficult to see how we can manage our role without checking the reports.
- In addition, now that small emitters can use the output of the Eurocontrol ETS-SF and by pass the 'verification' steps, the Competent Authority needs check all such reports, even if only to confirm that they have been copied over correctly.
- In stationary, there is a Commission <u>risk based matrix (Excel)</u> to determine reports from which installations to review, using the historic information in the AEM Reports. **Is it time for an Aviation one?**
