1. COUNTRY HIGHLIGHTS


Close to seven in ten respondents in Slovakia say that climate change is a "very serious" problem (68%). When comparing it with other issues, 13% identify it as the most serious problem facing the world (close to the EU average of 15%). Nearly half believe that government and business should be responsible for tackling climate change (both 48%).


More than four in ten respondents say they have personally taken some action to fight climate change in the past six months (43%, below the EU average of 49%). However, when presented with a list of specific measures, 93% reveal they have carried out at least one action. The main practical measures taken are:

- Trying to reduce waste and regularly separate it for recycling (70%)
- Trying to cut down consumption of disposable items whenever possible (51%)
- Buying locally produced food whenever possible. This measure has gained significant ground since 2013 (49%,
- +16 percentage points since 2013)


There is a strong consensus (83%) that fighting climate change and using energy more efficiently can boost the economy and create jobs. More than nine in ten respondents (94%) agree that fighting climate change will only be effective if all countries of the world act together.












