

# Verification and accreditation according to the EU MRV Regulation

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
## Regulation (EU)2015/757 Shipping MRV Regulation

- 1st step gradual approach providing for transparency of information on CO2 emissions and energy efficiency
- EU-wide monitoring & reporting obligations for all ships from 5000 GT calling at EU ports from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018 (flag neutral approach)
- Robust annual data verified by an accredited third party: backbone of the MRV

### Verification under the MRV Regulation

- Essential aspects of verification set in the MRV Regulation (Chapter III)
- **Verifiers** to:
  - assess the conformity of the monitoring plans (MP);
  - assess the conformity of the emissions report (ER);
  - issue a **verification report** with an opinion statement on the ER and specifying all issues spotted during the verification process;
  - issue and communicate a "MRV document of compliance" (DoC) to be held on board





### Verification under the MRV Regulation

- Scope/tasks verification activities: Article 13
- General obligations and principles for verifiers: Article 14
- Verification Procedures: Article 15





## Article 13 Assessment of conformity of Monitoring Plans

- Assessment against legal requirements under Article 6 and 7 (substantial and formal) and Annexes I and II
- Process for revising non-conformities and timeframe for revision allowing for final assessment by the verifier before the starting of reporting period
- Part A of Annex III elements on which further rules can be developed through delegated acts: "assessment of monitoring plans"





## Article 13 Verification of Emissions Reports

- Assessment based on legal requirements (Arts 8 to 12 & Annexes I & II);
- Process for dealing with non-conformities and misstatements, including companies' obligation to timely correct them to allow the verification process to be completed in time;
- Verifiers' conclusions and main relevant issues in a verification report either "satisfactory" or "not in compliance" in case of non-corrected issues leading to material misstatements;
- Part A of Annex III elements on which further rules can be developed through delegated acts: "verification of the emissions reports", "content of the verification report", "recommendations for improvements", notions of "reasonable assurance", "misstatements" and "non-conformities" and "materiality", etc.





### Article 14 General obligations and principles for the verifiers

- Independent impartial verifiers
- Reliability, accuracy & credibility of information: attributed fuel consumption/voyage,...
- List of minimum requirements for emissions reports to be considered by verifiers enabling determination of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions with reasonable assurance:
  - ✓ Submitted in accordance with templates and rules (Article 12)
  - ✓ Coherent with estimated data (ship tracking data)
  - √ Free of inconsistencies
  - ✓ Data collection carried in line with applicable rules
  - ✓ Complete and consistent records





### **Article 15 Verification procedures**

- Identify potential risks related to monitoring and reporting by comparing reported and estimated data (ship tracking data)
- Consideration of effective control risks methods applied by the companies, to reduce uncertainty associate with accuracy specific to a monitoring method
- Companies' obligation to provide additional information to the verifiers
- Verifier's possibility to conduct spot checks
- Part A of Annex III elements on which further rules can be developed through delegated acts: "risk assessment", "uncertainty" and "documents to be provided by companies to verifiers"





### Legal mandate on Verification issues

- Article 15 (5) mandate to the Commission to further specify rules for MRV verification activities (delegated acts)
- Taking into account list under Part A Annex III of the MRV Regulation





#### **Accreditation of MRV verifiers**

- Independent and competent legal entities accredited by an EU National Accreditation Body (NAB), pursuant to Regulation 765/2008
- Aspects of accreditation set under Regulation 765/2008 (Accreditation Regulation) apply to accreditation under MRV Regulation unless specific rules are developed
- Accreditation process to be put in place by end of 2016





### Legal mandate on Accreditation issues

- Article 16 (3) mandate to the Commission to further specify the accreditation process of MRV (delegated acts)
- List under **Annex III part B** of the MRV Regulation contains elements to be potentially translated into specific rules beyond Regulation 765/2008
  - Request for accreditation to NAB
  - Requirements for NABs
  - Assessment of verifiers by NABs
  - NABs surveillance of MRV verifiers
