



Excel template approach






Excel template approach

- Several means of communication (phone, email, fax, ...)
- MRV information through files (Excel, CSV, ...)
- Storage of information distributed among parties
- Publication of information requires compilation of files
- Harmonisation through the mandatory use of templates
- Version control of templates is required



Integrated web-based tool approach





Integrated web-based tool approach

- Communications centralised in one system
- MRV information reported in predefined web-forms
- Storage of information centralised in one system
- Facilitated publication of information
- Harmonisation through the use of the web-based tool
- Version control only for one system




