Article 6 of the Paris Agreement:

- > 3 instruments for cooperative implementation
 - Art. 6.2: Cooperative approaches between parties
 Bilateral Agreements for ITMOs (Internationally Transferred Mitigation Outcomes)
 - Art. 6.4 Centralized Mechanism for Emission Reductions
 One set of rules, Supervisory Body, similar to Clean Development Mechanism (KP)
 - Art. 6.8 Framework for Non-Market Approaches
 Technology Transfer, Capacity Building, Best Practices Exchange.

COP26: Glasgow Decision

- Definition of units (ITMOs) and the possible uses
- Participant requirements and accounting rules
- Reporting, review and Infrastructures
- Finance for adaptation (SoP) + mandatory cancelation of % of units (OMGE)
- Governance and rules for the 6.4 Mechanism (Methodologies, transition from CDM, etc)

COP27: Sharm El Sheikh Decision

- Reporting process (Initial Report, Annual Information, Regular Information)
- Review process
- Reporting infrastructure and Registries
- Some issues for the **6.4 Mechanism** (Registry, transition of activities, fees, crediting periods, etc)

High Quality standards and infrastructure

- VCM vs independent new set of standards
- Alignment with PA goals
- Infrastructure and tracking of units



Use of removals for offsetting emissions

- Preserved for hard to abate sectors ¿?
- Reversals
- Equity

Initiatives besides the negotiation rooms

- EUA: Blue Carbon
- USA: Energy Transition Accelerator (ETA) + Leaf Coalition
- EU: Call to action for Paris Aligned Carbon Markets









4 – Possible outcomes



- Positive: EU expectations are satisfied and the A6 can be implemented fully next year
- Neutral: conflicting items will be dealt with next year in a Work Program
- Negative: EU expectations are not satisfied and the A6 is implemented without the necessary quality on standards
