Dear Sir or Madame,

I would like to report my firm opposition to the actions proposed by the Commission and indicate that it leads to an increase in energy prices in Poland, which translates into a loss of competitiveness of our economy and pushes an increasing number of households in fuel poverty area. It may be recalled that the purpose of the introduction from 2004 of the European trading scheme was to reduce the emission of greenhouse gas emissions in the EU at the lowest possible cost.

How does this plan of Comission is in accordance with lowest possible cost when it would result in higher EUA prices? Is it really in terms of reducing greenhouse gas emissions, is the costs of such activities are as low as possible, or is the main purpose of these actions is to eliminate of the use of technology perceived poorly by the European Commission? I recon that the Commission has no legitimacy to this type of activities that are within the competence of the Member States?
