- Work in the EA CC EU ETS Network Group
- Co-operation with the A&V Task Force

Work in the **EA CC EU ETS Network Group: EA CC EU ETS Network Group** meeting 19-20/05/2015 in Ljubljana:

2. DEVELOPMENTS

Work within the EA CC EU ETS Network Group: EA NABs use **the new templates** for verifier notification (art. 76) and for the Work Programme (art. 70), adding the **Activity Group** and **Verification Team**



3. Interface between CA and NAB

Importance:

- Continuos improvement
- Transparency and knowledge of the task of AB and CA

Best Practices:

- Regular meetings (involving CA, verifiers and AB)
- Direct communication (phone, e mail)
- Additional explanations with the Managment Report (art 70)
 to understand the "outstanding non conformities"
- Use of **new templates** for verifier notification (art. 76) and for the Work Programme (art. 70)



3. Interface between CA and NAB

Information exchange from art 72:

- AB to select the witnessing assessment and/or plan the next verifier assessment
- A wide overview of the verifier performance (Incl. in others MS)
- To guarantee correction of weak points before the next verification campaign

Information exchange, Work Programme art 70:

Potencial use by the CA:

- To carry out inspection activity on the operator,
- To "know" the AB assessment in the witnessing,
- To know the foreign verifiers activity within its MS,
