- Exchanging information on AER validation
- Collecting experience/examples of useful automated IT evaluation rules
- Discussing concepts and experiences concerning inspections (on-site) to make a better practical use of this instrument
- Discussing MR issues based on updated implementation practices and new findings, inter alia
 - CEMS practice (esp. quality assurance), Quality control of measuring devices,
 - Representativeness of sampling.
- Discussing individual cases on implementation issues
- Start with the collection of issues that may be picked up for MRR2020

Issues on the 6th Compliance Conference

- Significant vs. non-significant changes of the MP – objective criteria
- Unreasonable costs – exchange of anonymised real-life cases
- Simplified monitoring plans – revisit the potentials
