### Reporting

- ♦ 92% of expected reports were received
- ⇒ 37% used simplified reporting (EUROCONTROL data)
- All reports were checked for accuracy
  - 8% of verified reports had an error identified
  - 2.5% of the simplified reports had an error identified
- ◆ 43% of the verified reports had a verifier recommendation for an improvement report
- 1 site visit was performed by a CA, 1 is planned
- Most Member States actively look for new AO's and communicate with existing AO's

#### **Debt Recovery**

- Outstanding 2012 penalties to be issued
- ◆ 104 of the penalties issued remain unpaid in 6 MS's
- ◆ These 6 MS's have started Debt Recovery proceedings
- Costs will often exceed the penalty
- Detention of aircraft and operating bans difficult or sensitive
- Likely scenario...debts written off?
- Integrity / fairness of the scheme....non-EU AO's get away with it?





#### **EUROCONTROL**

- Dealing with data changes during a year
- ◆ AO's split between MS's and under threshold
- AO's still assigned to MS even though no activity
- Status of "never attributed" AO's
- Contacting AO when no reliable contact information available





### 2017 - 2020 and beyond

- What if any are the changes to EU ETS Aviation?
- What is the timetable?
- When will this be communicated?
- Will 2017 allocation be affected?





#### **Information Sharing**

- Helicopters and need for guidance?
- Feedback on biofuels and is guidance fit for purpose?
- Site visit waivers for emissions >25,000 tCO₂?
- When are new AO's contacted?
- Is a having monitoring plan necessary for new operators to issue a AER?
- Transfer of AO to another MS (with surrender deficit)?
- Enforcement against non-responsive or noncooperative AO's?
