### Main objectives of TF AV

- Share experiences on AV issues and learn from each other
- Provide input into Commission projects (e.g. review AVR, guidances)
- TF meetings, email exchange
- EA ETS network group represented in TF meetings

#### Benefits of participation in TF:

- Better understanding of AVR requirements and of the roles of CA, verifier and NAB
- Reduces barriers to contact colleagues in other MS



#### Main activities in 2022

- TF AV shared experiences on the implementation of the AVR, most specifically on:
  - Verification of biomass-related issues
  - Experiences on virtual site visits and verification of annual activity level reports
  - Experiences with the CA's evaluation of internal verification documentation
  - Verifier's capacity and impact on verification
- TF AV discussed impact on Fit for 55 Package proposal (high level discussion), mostly on verification in ETS maritime sector
- EA gave regular updates on developments in accreditation and surveillance of verifiers



#### Summary of AV break out session

- Focus on verification of annual activity level data
  - 3 CA (IE, DK and NO) gave their experiences on the review of ALCR and VR
  - 1 NAB (RO) gave their experiences on surveillance of verifiers carrying out verification of ALCR and issues
    identified in the verification

#### Conclusion

- Clear reduction in errors compared to 2021 (first year of ALCR verification)
- Similar types of issues were identified across Member States: e.g. heat BM issues, typical errors
- Better understanding of the rules by CA, Verifiers and NAB but there are still some complex areas where parties struggle how can we help?
- Verifier's time allocation and time pressure is a problem but we all have to deal with it how to do that?
- Some concerns were voiced on verifier's capacity given the increasing number of ETS activities
- Next year we will continue the work on these topics in the TF AV group



## **Looking towards 2023**

- Continue to share experiences, provide input in COM projects and coordinate with EA
- Suggestions for topics are welcome → Likely topics include:
  - Verification of biomass and the role of the verifier
  - CORSIA verification and EU ETS
  - Verifier capacity
  - Experiences on the review of AERs and annual activity level data
  - Improving guidance on data sampling
  - Discussion on the impact of fit for 55 package proposals to verification
