

- Appreciation that AVR utilised rules from EA-6/03
- No problems with competence assessment
- No significant changes in assessment approach
- ISO 14065 revision
- Difficulties with information exchange

The anticipated time and place of the verification are hardly feasible to get by 15 November.

For "new comers" it is a tight schedule to achieve!

# **Proposals for future**

- Stabilise the system!
- Reconsider feasibility and added value of requirements on information exchange
- I don't see necessity of additional guidance documents
- Organise training sessions to achieve harmonised implementation.
  Preferably in Member States
