Approval of MPs and information

- Approval
 - 21 CAs at regional level
 - EPA s role – guidance to operators and regional CAs
 - Template in Swedish recently finished
 - We are waiting for GD1 translation in Swedish
 - We expect the new MPs in October
- Information

 - Conference with operators in May (installations and aviation)
 - Conference with CAs in August

Specific problem

- Co-incineration
 - ~ 10 completely new installations
 - ~ 20 partly new installations
 - Category A and B
 - The incinerated waste is normally a mixture of different kinds of waste
 - Intensive discussions with industry
 - Lots of data on contents in waste

Monitoring emissions from co-incineration

- Our present approach
 - Category A installations
 - Calculation
 - Calculation factors from National Inventory (UNFCCC)
 - Category B installations
 - CEMS
 - Biomass fraction determined by C14 method in flue gas or calculated by “balance method”
