


Around eight in ten respondents in Spain think climate change is a "very serious" problem (79%, well above the EU average of 69%). Almost six in ten "totally agree" that fighting climate change and using energy more efficiently can boost the economy in the EU (58%, compared to an EU average of 37%).

Nearly two-thirds of respondents say that they have personally taken some action to fight climate change in the past six months (66%, well above the EU average of 49%). The main measures taken are:

- Trying to reduce waste and regularly separate it for recycling (76%, no change since 2013)
- Cutting down consumption of disposable items such as plastic bags whenever possible (57%, +7 percentage points since 2013)
- Buying locally produced and seasonal food whenever possible (39%, +10 percentage points since 2013)
- Using environmentally-friendly alternatives to private cars (35%, +10 percentage points since 2013)

More than nine out of ten (95%) people in Spain agree that fighting climate change will only be effective if all countries of the world act together. The vast majority (93%) believe that it is important that their government sets targets to increase the amount of renewable energy used, such as wind or solar power, and provides support for improving energy efficiency (92%) by 2030.






EU28 🚺 Outer pie




QA3 In your opinion, who within the EU is responsible for tackling climate change? (MULTIPLE ANSWERS POSSIBLE)



QAS Have you personally taken any action to fight climate change over the past six months?






QA4.1 To what extent do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements? Fighting climate change and using energy more efficiently can boost the economy and jobs in the EU (%)





QA4.2 To what extent do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements? Fighting climate change will only be effective if all countries of the world act together (%)


