What has led us to the A&V Forum 2013?

- 1st EU ETS Verification Forum: 19 June 2007
- 2nd EU ETS Verification Forum: 25 April 2008
- 3rd EU ETS Verification Forum: 19 November 2008
- Phase 2 requirements, but also the prelude for revision of Article 15 EU ETS Directive, in particular paragraph 4:

By 31 December 2011, the Commission shall adopt a regulation for the verification of emission reports based on the principles set out in Annex V and for the accreditation and supervision of verifiers. It shall specify conditions for the accreditation and withdrawal of accreditation, for mutual recognition and peer evaluation of accreditation bodies, as appropriate.





Aims of the 2013 A&V Forum

- Confirmed understanding of the requirements affecting EU ETS from Phase III (emissions from 1st January 2013)
- Raised awareness of available guidance and templates
- Reassurance of on-going activities supporting implementation:
 - Progress on peer review of NABs
 - Progress on accreditation of verifiers
 - Progress of verifiers towards timely Year 1 verification reports
