# MRV Regulation essential elements monitoring methods rules

- Imposes "per voyage", with limited exceptions, and "annual" monitoring obligations (Articles 9 and 10).
- Sets a lean approach: gives companies a choice among 4 monitoring methods (Article 8 & Annex I part B) to be documented in the Monitoring Plan.
- The Comission through delegated acts is empowered for a period of 5 years to:
  - amend (non-essential) elements of the monitoring methods and rules under Annex I and II Article 5(2) to take into account relevant international rules and international and Europea standards
  - refine elements of the monitoring methods in the light of technological and scientific development





### MRV Regulation Annex I: methods for monitoring CO2 emissions

#### Part A - Calculation of CO2 emissions

Formula for calculations / Default values for emission factors

#### Part B - Methods for determining CO2 emissions

- **BDN and regular stocktaking of fuel tanks** (periodicity, conversion from volume into mass, circumstances where this monitoring method is excluded,...)
- Bunker fuel tank monitoring on-board (periodicity of tank readings conversion from volume to mass,...-
- **Fuel flow meters** (periodicity, inclusion of calibration and uncertainty in the Monitoring Plan,..)
- **Direct CO2 emissions measurement** (scope, method to determine of CO2 emissions)
- Room for combination of monitoring methods to enhance accuracy (assessed by the verifier)





# MRV Regulation Annex II Monitoring of other relevant information

Part A "Monitoring on a per voyage basis"
Sets the rules for calculation of:

- a) Time at sea
- b) Distance travelled
- c) Transport work
- d) to g) Cargo carried for passengers, ro-ro, containers and other ships

Part B "Monitoring on an annual basis" sets the rules for calculation of average energy efficiency
