1. COUNTRY HIGHLIGHTS


Seven in ten respondents in Belgium think that climate change is a 'very serious' problem (70%, EU average 74%), while roughly one in six see it as the most serious problem facing the world (17%, EU average 12%).


Less than half of those surveyed say they have personally taken action to fight climate change in the past six months (47%, EU average 49%). However, when given specific examples this rises to almost all respondents (98%, EU average 90%), suggesting that many do not associate certain actions with tackling climate change.

- Nearly three-quarters say that they try to reduce waste and regularly separate it for recycling (73%, EU average 71%).
- A majority of respondents in Belgium try to cut down on use of disposable items such as plastic bags and excessive packaging whenever possible (59%, EU average 56%).
- Slightly less than half (46%) take lower energy consumption into account when buying a new household appliance, notably above the EU average (37%), although this share has fallen by 11 percentage points since the previous survey in 2015.

The proportion of respondents who agree that reducing fossil fuel imports from third countries can benefit the EU economically (60%) is slightly below the EU average (65%). However, around eight in ten agree that promoting EU expertise in new clean technologies to third countries can benefit the EU economically (79%, EU average 77%) and that more public financial support should be given to the transition to clean energies (80%, EU average 79%).








