AVR Update

- Commission Regulation (EU) No. 600/2012 adopted 21 June 2012
- Will affect emissions and tonne-kilometre data from 1st January 2013, but preparations required
- Some new requirements for some MSs; some new requirements for all MSs, e.g. AVR Chapter VI Information Exchange
- Links to MRR, AR 765/2008, EN ISO 14065, EN ISO/IEC 17011, the EA, EA-6/03, peer reviews
- Harmonised interpretation and implementation vital to the credibility of ETS verification and to support mutual recognition of verifiers





Preparations for Year 1 (2013)

- Verifiers:
 - Procedures, competences updated
 - Applications for accreditation updates (or certification)
 - Earlier start to 2013 data verifications due to new MPs/monitoring methodology/systems, new verification requirements (including internal report documentation), compulsory site visits for installations
 - Information exchange by 15 November 2013
- NABs/NCAs:
 - Procedures, competences, M&R knowledge updated
 - Peer evaluation/NCA equivalent
 - Processing new requests for accreditation
 - Information exchange by 31 December





EA and CA Preparations

- European cooperation for Accreditation:
 - Update of EA-6/03 (EA Document for recognition of verifiers under the EU ETS Directive)
 - Training NABs
 - Implementation of appropriate peer review requirements
 - Facilitation and harmonisation of NAB/NCA databases
- MS/CAs:
 - Monitoring NAB/NCA performance and appropriate action, including in respect to peer reviews (Article 65)
 - Mutual recognition of verifiers (Article 66)
 - Response to NAB/NCA work programmes (Article 70.2)





Objectives of 2012 AV guidance project

- To develop a suite of guidance documents that:
 - Supports the harmonised interpretation and application of the AV regulation
 - Does not create supplementary requirements compared to the AVR
 - Addresses the verification of installations and aircraft operators
 - Provides a practical and user-friendly package to assist verifiers, NABs, NCAs, the EA, CAs and operators/aircraft operators





Benefits of CCC endorsed guidance

- Available to all MSs. No need for re-invention or duplication
- "Assurance" of AVR compliance
- Greater harmonisation, supporting mutual recognition
- Administrative efficiency due to familiarity (IT compatible)
- Added confidence in ETS data integrity/ETS credibility

Note the importance of 2012 developments to provide timely input and support to necessary 2013 preparations





Priorities for 2013 Guidance Project

- Completion of intended suite (as relevant): User manual/general guidance; Key Guidance Notes; Templates; 'Exemplars'; FAQ
- Improvement of existing guidance based on further findings, e.g. from trial of templates on 2012 data?
- Development of further relevant guidance, e.g. verification of sustainable biofuel/bioliquid source streams
