#### **Compliance Forum activities in 2023**

- 6 Steering Committee meetings per year;
- Task Force meetings: M&R, A&V, Aviation. The 4<sup>th</sup> TF is restarting CCS;
- Compliance Forum events: 1 to 2 trainings in 2023;
- 14<sup>th</sup> EU ETS Compliance Conference: November 2023;
- Brochure and bulletin prepared twice per year;
- Support from the Secretariat for the Compliance Forum activities and events.



### Update of MRR and AVR guidance documents, templates and tools

- The ETS MRVA guidance materials are being updated for phase 4 of the EU ETS;
- The update covers all the new legal developments, in particular the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> update of the MRR and AVR;
- MRR updated Guidance document 3 on biomass recently published in October 2022;
- MRR Process on updating the Guidance document 1 (MRR general guidance for installations. Minor changes related to biomass) and 2 (MRR – general guidance for aircraft operators. On biofuels and relationship with CORSIA) will start in early 2023.
- AVR Key Guidance Note II.3 on process analysis updated recently, to be published soon.
- GD III on verification in ETS aviation to be updated in relation to biofuels, similar as GD2 (to be aligned)
- The AER data extraction tool that checks the integrity of the AER for installations; an update is expected by end of March 2023.

#### **Article 21 reporting**

Updated Article 21 questionnaire for ETS phase 4 published in June 2022;

- 1st MS reporting for phase 4 by 30 June 2022 analysis of MS responses to Article 21 has been concluded;
- COM Carbon Market Report to be published in early 2023;
- COM Article 21 Technical Report to be published Q2 2023, previous one published in June 2022;
- next MS reporting by 30 June 2023;
- new features in the ETS reporting tool.




#### Analysis of the use of auction revenues

#### MRR and AVR revision




**Commission's proposal** lists in Annex III the scope of the new ETS to cover the following:


- 1. Fuels put on the market and combusted in **buildings** (residential and commercial) and in **road transport**.
- 2. Fuels put on the market and consumed in **district heating installations** (not covered by Annex I) to the extent that heat is exported to buildings.

European Commission

The Commission adds Part C to Annex IV, which sets out the **principles of monitoring and reporting for the Building and Road Transport sectors (BRT)** and a Part C to Annex V regarding the criteria for the **verification** of emissions, respectively.

#### MRR and AVR revision





New MRVA Rules

- The monitoring rules for BRT are anticipated to be simpler than the existing ones for stationary installations, since they only cover combustion emissions.
- BRT emissions appear to better correspond to existing aviation requirements, and do not demand any industrial sector-specific elements such as process emissions, mass balances or non-CO2 greenhouse gas emissions.
- Monitoring Plan (MP) and Annual Emission Report (AER) templates for BRT will be developed in due time.
- Development of MRVA rules for waste incineration;
- Review/ development of MRVA rules for CCU and RFNBO;
- The detailed MRV rules will be developed once the revised Directive is adopted by the Council and the Parliament, then the **TWG-MRVA members** will be invited to contribute.
- Improvements will also concern individual articles related to EU-ETS, for cases that were not sufficiently covered until now after the latest MRR/AVR revision, and which were pointed out by Member States with queries to the COM.
- MRV Regulation (EU) 2015/757 for Maritime transport will remain independent from MRR.





### ETS Reporting tool – MRV (e-reporting)



#### ETS Reporting Tool (ERT) for MRV – a brief overview

- Project kicked-off in March 2019 with 18 stakeholders;
- First web forms for Monitoring Plan (installations) delivered in Dec 2020;
- Web forms for Annual Emission Reports, Verification Reports and Improvement Reports deployed in 2022;
- Excel files also accepted for aviation reports (MP, AER, VR, IR), but no automatic validation;
- 1400 operators from BE, SE, IE, IS, ES, LV, MT, RO, SK, ES... (GR now on-boarding);
- 2350 submissions to date;
- Dedicated Service Desk (same as for the Union Registry);
- Continuous improvement (Incident, Problem and Change Management) 10 releases in 2022;
- Feedback welcome, survey to be sent soon.



#### ETS Reporting Tool (ERT) for MRV – benefits

- Web forms directly accessible to the operators
  - instant validation, pre-fill of data, less duplication, increase data consistency and quality, standardisation (XML-XETL);
- Streamlined process
  - Processes discussed and agreed by all stakeholders → workflows are common to all Competent Authorities;
- Traceability and transparency
  - all actions are audited and available to the CA users (reduced view for operators);
- Possible integrations (interoperability)
  - EU Login, EUTL, EUCR, EU-Sign, systems from other Institutions (EEA, Eurocontrol etc...) and Competent Authorities;
- Data available in structured format for analytics and reporting (e.g. Art 21 extracts);
- IT cost savings for the Competent Authorities.



#### ETS Reporting Tool (ERT) for MRV - Demo



- Operator: submit Monitoring Plan.
- CA: Approve Monitoring Plan.
- Operator: create AER from Monitoring Plan.
- Operator: submit AER
- Operator: Assign Verifier
- Verifier: Create Verification report
- CA: extract reporting data (e.g. for Article 21 filling)
