Organisation & findings of AER/IR validation by CA

- Feedback by CZ, BE, UK, NL, ES, PL, DE, IT, CR
- All reports were checked, but:
 - In different time
 - With a different number of staff;
 - Hence, probably in a different depth
- Still need for improvements by operators
- Misstatements still detected by CA after verification
- Templates often filled out in the wrong way
- Improvement recommendations often less relevant, leading to (needless) bureaucratic effort for operators and CA



Work to be done by TF M&R

- Continuing & expanding exchange of information
- Checklists & priorities for CA validations
- Some clarifications on MRR (perhaps also in preparation for 4th phase)
- Handling of diverse M&R issues in practice
- Guidance on Art. 21 report (???)
- Training for CA validators / inspectors



Closing remarks

- "It is no problem anymore to address problems"
- TF work serves as a training for its members as well
