

Validation


- Validation of Monitoring Plans focus on monitoring methodology
 complete filled in MP template, correct tiers
- Limited check on Emission Reports mainly typing errors
- More extensive scrutinising of non-conformities in Verification Statements – feeds into inspection plan
- CA need not put too much effort on checking reports since there already is a third party check by the verifiers





Inspection


- Planned inspection according to annual Inspection Plan
- Limited inspection due to small resources desk review if possible, only site visits on plants considered high priority by CA
- Issues found by Verifiers gives basis for CA inspection
- Trust in work done by Verifiers but with close cooperation with Accreditation Body and meetings with Verifiers





Enforcement

- Effort on establishing harmonised and correct work between Verifiers
- Differences in the reporting by Verifiers amount and type of reported non-conformities differ
 - Measure: Implement IT-system for reporting
- Less errors in permits after introducing permit application forms according to the UK model
- Not optimal formation with decentralised CA
 - Permit Authority: 21 County Administrative Boards





Sanctions

- Late reporting fee
- CA decides on emissions when verification opinion statement on emission report is negative
- Some cases of operators not handing in Emission Allowances on time 40 €/ tonne



Summary

- CA makes inspection with limited resources, planned inspection activities
- Focus on verification result, do not redo the work of the Verifiers
- Feedback to parties involved
 - Other CA:s (registry, permits)
 - Accreditation Body
 - Verifiers
- Compliance Forum is needed
- We expect new possibilities to co-operation between CA:s
 - Web platform for FAQ and exchange of views
 - Workshops on experience with validation of monitoring plans
