Task Force IV CCS

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Activities in 2016

- Currently there is relatively little initiative to extend CCS in Europe.
- Projects in planning phase, mainly in countries with possibilities of offshore storage.
- Task Force meeting in October was cancelled due to low demand.
- Discussions with Norway started on the Norwegian government's planned investments in CO₂ projects. Question of the inclusion of other types of transport than CO₂ pipelines.



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Proposals for activities in 2017

- Engaging more Member States to participate in the TF CCS and its activities.
- Examining new CCS activities in particular that the Norwegian Government has stated that it will invest on a broad front to develop cost-effective technology for CCS and seek to construct at least one full full-scale demonstration plant by 2020 for updating the 2015 Status report on CCS (Legal implementation of the CCS-Directive in EU MS, overview of large-scale integrated CCS projects in EU and other continents).
- Developing an exemplar monitoring plan concerning transportation of CO₂ (transport via pipelines, ships, vessels, railroad or road tankers), in addition to the already existing monitoring plans on capture and storage.
- Considering approaches for CO₂ capture and transport in the context of CCU (Carbon Capture and Utilisation) to take industrial applications (Chemical industry, Cement & lime, Power to Gas and Power to Liquid activities) into account. This activity will be coordinated with the TF Monitoring and Reporting.
- A Task Force meeting on demand.
