

- Verification Regulation
- Guidance Documents and Templates for
 - Monitoring Plan
 - Annual Emissions Report
- Central Focus on Description of Data Flow Activities (Art. 57) and Control Activities (Art.58)
- Role of Competent Authorities and Verifier



The Monitoring & Reporting Regulation 2012

NOLE OF COMPETENT AUTHORITIES AND VERIFIER

Competent Authority

- Approval of the Monitoring Plan
- Major Modifications
- Allocation (new entrants, activity & capacity levels, etc.)
- Improvements

Verifier

- Coherence of Documents and Application of Procedures
- Risk Analysis
- Annual Emissions

TE CARBON SERVICES

- > ROLE OF XETL
- Will without doubt make data transfer easier
- Can be used as database or connected to databases
- Will avoid data transfer in too many formats
 - Belgium Flemish Region: MP is *.doc document
 - Belgium Walloon Region: MP is ETSWAP
 - Netherlands MP is excel sheet
- Will facilitate Exchange between operators, verifiers and competent authorities

The Monitoring & Reporting Regulation 2012

> CONCLUSION

- XETL will facilitate up-stream data and document management
- XETL should be extended to handle efficiently
 - Modification management (logbook)
 - Incident management (logbook)
- XETL should become available as soon as possible to avoid to many different systems
- XETL does not avoid operator's responsibility for
 - Document coherence
 - Transparent data flow activities
