Peer-evaluation process (1)

Implementation of the EA MLA for ISO 14065 including all requirements of the ETS scheme

Peer evaluation for this MLA activity will cover compliance with ISO 17011 and ISO 14065, and EU ETS specific issues, i.e. requirements in the AV regulation and related documents

Competence requirements for peer evaluation team similar to assessment team competence



Peer-evaluation process (2)

Initial peer-evaluation for ISO 14065 (ETS)

Process to implement the new MLA being prepared by a special taskforce, being accepted by the EA MAC and endorsed at the spring 2012 EA GA

Application (MLA signatory) with information on experience, procedures and competence, status for implementation of 14065 and ETS requirements



Peer-evaluation process (3)

- Assignment of Team Leader & Team Members
- Documentation to Team for review
- Evaluation desk and /or visit
- List of findings Non-conformities/ Concerns/Comments
- Draft report to AB for comments
- Corrective actions by the AB
- Final report including the Team's comments and recommendation



Peer-evaluation process (4)

- Evaluation Report to be studied by assigned EA-MAC Task Force Group
- Recommendation to EA-MAC
- Decision by EA-MAC
 - Approval to become signatory of the new MLA activity or
 - Additional evidence for fulfilling criteria required
- Result to the national authority responsible for the accreditation body, the national ETS Competent Authority and the Commission plus presentation on the EA homepage



Peer-evaluation default process for AB's not to be peer evaluated until mid 2014

- A special expert group being formed
- Document review of specified set of documents
- Peer evaluation at the AB premises
- Witness of accreditation assessment of a verifier being conducted by the AB
- Report to be fed in the normal decision process



Planning for peer evaluations for the third trading period

Peer evaluations including ISO 14065 (ETS) started

2012 6 AB's, 2013 12 AB's, 2014 3 AB's

Default peer evaluation process

2013 6 AB's, until mid 2014 5 AB's
