Decision 2012: IT-system = useful!



Options IT-system Wallonia

Options:

- 1. Development new system by AwAC/Wallonia
- 2. Development new system (from zero) by consultant
- 3. Use an existing IT-system with minor modifications

Requirements

- System compatible with phase III
- ASAP available (deadline MP: sept/octobre 2012)
- Language (FR/ENG)
- Reasonable costs

Concept ETSWAP Wallonia

- Based upon UK version ETSWAP
- Min content: phase III ETS-templates
- Modified for Walloon requirements
 - Deadlines in Walloon legislation (assessment)
 - No charges in Wallonia for operators
 - Minor changes in workflow, due to specifications in Walloon legislation and role DPA/AwAC



Development ETSWAP Wallonia

- Development spread over 2 years (2012/2013)
 - Human resources
 - Time restrictions
 - Availability of phase III-documents (templates, etc)
- Release 1: delivered in September 2012
 - Based upon 1 workshop + several conference calls
 - Scope: MP
- Release 2: delivered in April 2013
- Release 3: foreseen before end 2013





Hosting/support/licence ETSWAP Wallonia

- Hosting: by SFW
- Support/maintenance: by SFW (minimum support of IT-service AwAC at start)
- Licence: licence fee for 150 operators



Contract documents

- Contract
- SLA (service level agreement)
- Licence agreement
- Source code contract (sort of assurance)







- Development
 - Only costs in 2012-2013
 - Depending on number and impact of modifications
- Licence fee
 - Annual cost
 - Depending on number of operators
- Hosting/support costs
 - Annual cost
- Contract source code
 - Annual cost







- Operational unit of ETS-team (2/3 persons)
 - Fluctuating workload
 - Input for development
 - 1st help for operators = AwAC
- Our tasks during development phase
 - Workshop or conference call to discuss existing functionalities
 - Evaluate and modify forms/workflows/output documents
 - Testing before going 'live'





- General informations about operators (fix installations/aviation)
- Monitoring Plans (phase III) + modifications
- Improvement reports
- AEM-reports + verification reports
- Inspections + reports
- Allocations: new entrant reserve/significant capacity/ partial cessations/definitive cessations
- Transfer
- Non-compliance
- Art. 21 report
- Other output-reports possible



ETSWAP: security data/roles

- Different types of users:
 - Competent authority
 - Operator
 - Verifier
- 1 access/user (login/password)
- Functionalities depending on roles



ETSWAP: our experiences (1)

- Facilitates tasks operators and CA users (time benefit)
- Central data storage for ETS information
- Reporting = easier
- Very professional partner (developers + support team), good awareness of requirements MRR, flexible and solution-oriented
- Benefit from 'lessons learnt' from ETSWAP UK
- Operators are positive
- Stable product
- Extraction of data foreseen in easily readable format
- Log of all communications with operators





ETSWAP: our experiences (2)

- **ETSWAP** Wallonia still in English
 - => translation in French foreseen (2014)
- Human resources has to be made available, especially during development phases!
- Disponibility of european documentation in time
 lack of visibility on what can be be developed in which release and potential related additional costs.
