## Involving verifier in information exchange

- Involving verifier may help to give NABs more clarification about the issue
- Care should be taken to amend the AVR as this can affect the roles and responsibilities of the parties involved
- Shift of burden from NABs to CA should be avoided
- Template for information exchange CA to NAB should be reviewed
- TF is the platform to exchange experiences on information exchange with EA and MS and to improve efficiency of information exchange process (e.g. template)





## **Activity data**

- Phase 4 allocation rules will have a major impact on the process of allocation of free allowances
- Annual monitoring and reporting of activity data will be needed to ensure compliance with the allocation rules
- It is broadly recognized that allocation rules are complex and there are lots of verification issues.
  Additional and dedicated Guidance for verifiers could help to improve the verification process. TWG on benchmarking should lead but TF AV can provide input.
