Errors	Installation category has to be "A", "B" or "C" (sheet C Installation Description)	 Monitoring Methodology cannot be derived from the provided value (sheet J accounting) Value doesn't match as a reference value in database (sheet B Installation Description)
Warnings	Required tier is not met (sheet E Source Streams)	 CRF category cannot derived from the provided value (sheet B Installation Description)



Why to use DECLARE?

- Backup→ all MP, AER, IR
- ☐ Integrity inspection of MP, AER, IR before approval
- ☐ Tier requirements on specific Source stream
- ☐ Integrity inspection of **NAT table** before submission
- ☐ Complete **Organisation details** and related history changes
- Aggregated data of all **submitted AER's** (emissions overview)
- Compliance cycle info for each installation for a given reporting period
- Overview of specific Reporting period classification



What else to expect?

- ☐ Cross checking between AER and MP
- Efficient overview data export, directly related with information for Art. 21 Report of the EU ETS Directive
- Enhanced consistency inspection of MPs and AERs, e.g. including implementation of the specified measurement systems in relevant source streams
- Automatic reminder for potential IR submissions from installations under the scope of Article 69 of MRR
