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Objectives

- Harmonize ETS Monitoring of CCS Systems by a common understanding of MRV requirements
- Assist Member States and other stakeholders concerning monitoring issues of CCS installations
- Safeguard ecologic integrity of CCS as a bridge technology



Activities & products

- Exchange of experience and information on legal implementation, research projects and recent industrial activities of CCS
 - → visits of capture facilities in Scotland, Germany, and Italy; storage in Ketzin (Germany)
- Exemplar Monitoring Plans available:
 - Monitoring Plan for a <u>capture facility</u>
 - Monitoring Plan to quantify CO₂ emissions for a storage facility
 (storage complex and surface installations)



Activities in 2015

- Status report on CCS:
 - Legal implementation of the CCS-Directive in EU MS
 - Overview of large-scale integrated CCS projects in Europe and other continents
- → Currently there is relatively little initiative to extend CCS in Europe!
 - Projects in planning phase, mainly in countries with possibilities of offshore storage.
 - NER 300: Peterhead project, Scotland (Post-combustion; 1m tons CO₂/a)



Future activities

- Development of an exemplar monitoring plan concerning transportation of CO₂
 - ... via pipelines, vessels or road transport
- CCU Carbon Dioxide as Feedstock for Fuels, Chemistry and Polymers
 - To take industrial applications (chemical industry, cement & lime into account
 - Power to Gas / Power to Liquid (PTG, PTL) activities
- → Engaging other Member States with upcoming CCS activities to participate in the TF
 - Next Task Force meeting?
