1. Project aims

- Evaluation of the implementation of the 2013/2014 EU ETS compliance cycle at MS level
 - Evaluate MS' compliance with the new regulatory requirements of the MRR and AVR
 - Analyse MS-specific provisions
- Analyse results highlighting
 - Best practices
 - Shortcomings and inconsistencies amongst MS
- Identify requirements that MS find difficult to implement
- Develop recommendations for improvement

3. Methodology

- Identification of key issues
- Questionnaire development
 - MRR and AVR provided more detailed basis as compared to 3rd review
- Case selection
- Data collection through interviews
 - Calibration interview
 - In-country or by phone
- Aggregation and analysis
- Reporting and sharing of outcomes



3.1 Data collection

- Input has been collected from all Member States + Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway
- Data gathered through interviews
 - In-country or phone
- Involvement of different levels
 - Central and regional CAs
 - NAB/NCA
 - Verifiers
- Review of country fiches & selected cases



3.2 Data processing

- Aggregation of findings
 - Descriptive and qualitative information: grouping most common answers and identifying patterns
 - Quantitative information as feasible
- Analysing findings to:
 - Identify common themes
 - Assess unresolved issues or inefficiencies
 - Establish good/best practices
 - Develop recommendations to EC and MS





4. Outputs

- **Country fiches** describe national processes and assess general compliance with the relevant requirements
- **Report** identifies topic- and sector-specific findings and presents recommendations where applicable
