- *In 2019 two TF AV meetings, attended by 15-16 CAs, EA and Commission*
- *Activities in 2019:*
 - ❖ *Survey on demonstration of compliance with sustainability criteria for biomass and the roles of verifiers and CAs*
 - ❖ *DE and DK shared experiences with checking internal verification documentation of verifiers*
 - ❖ *In April exchange of expectations for the upcoming verification of baseline data reports*
 - ❖ *In October IE and DK shared experiences on the assessment of FAR baseline data reports together with the verification reports*
