Main objective and activities

- Safeguard ecologic integrity of the bridge technology CCS
- Harmonize ETS Monitoring of CCS Systems by a common understanding of MRR requirements
- Assist Member States and other Stakeholders concerning monitoring issues
- Discuss Monitoring Questions with other Task Forces under the umbrella of the Compliance Forum

Summary of recent activities

- Currently relatively few initiatives to extend CCS
- Last Task Force meeting was held in Iceland 21st August 2018 incl. visit of the CarbFix project in Reykjavik
- Plans for investments in CCS projects in NOR and NL
- Initiatives in NO and NL for widening CCU in combination with CCS (CO₂-networks)
- Discussions:
 - Inclusion of other types of transport than pipelines
 - Inclusion of BECCS in EU-ETS regulations and the Directive
 - CO₂-networks

Looking towards 2020

- Considering approaches for CO₂ capture and transport in the context of CCU to take industrial applications into account
- How to deal with future CO₂-networks?
(coordinated with the TF Monitoring and Reporting)
- Examining new CCS activities – Updating the 2015 Status report on CCS
- Developing an exemplar monitoring plan concerning transportation of CO₂
- Medium to long-term: Discussion about Modification to EU-ETS regulations and about the Directive for Inclusion of BECCS
