# The set-up of the RA-forum

- Informal group under WGIII
- The Commission hosts the meetings
- Meetings 2-4 times a year
- Forum at Circa
- Contact-list with e-mail addresses and telephone numbers
- E-mails used inbetween meetings
- Sub-groups when needed

# Information shared within the forum

- Understanding of specific legal issues
- Need for changes in EU-regulation
- Information on bugs, misunderstandings and other errors of common interest
- Upcoming changes in IT system, legislation etc
- Planning of tests

# Interaction with the decision-level

- Informal sub-group to wgIII.
- Input to the Commission on changes of the regulation. Afterwards to be discussed at wgIII/CCC
- The Commission is chairing all meetings
- Input to the Commission on the cooperation with UN. MS also in contact with UN directly on some subjects – not always common understanding.

# Tips

- Meetings are important to make the CAs familiar with each other
- Moving meeting locations inbetween MS
- Informal group – keep policy for next level
- Find the right members
- A room at CIRCA to keep all important documents
- Interesting agendas
- Updated list of contact-persons
