■ General information

- **Kick-off meeting** November 2009 in Berlin
- **Members and participants** up to now: AT, BE, DK, EE, FR, FI, DE, HU, IT, NL, NO, PL, PT, ES, SE, UK + COM, UBA Austria
- **So far 12 meetings** in London, Oslo, The Haag, Berlin and Brussels (conferencing facilities in most cases available)

■ Membership

- **Representatives of all member states** are invited
- **External experts** cannot become regular members and also do not have access to SharePoint; depending on the topic, they can temporarily be invited to present their expert knowledge
- **Consultants contracted by the commission** who are working on Guidance papers are invited to attend all TF meetings

- **Objectives of the Task Force (TF) are**
 - **to discuss in an open exchange of views, the questions and issues of the MRR**
 - **aiming at jointly agreed solutions**
 - **to provide the Commission with input for Guidance papers and FAQs.**

■ TF working procedure

- **General Work Program** for every working phase
- **Detailed documentation** to manage the day-to-day TF information exchange
- **Issues guided and presented by TF members**; other members provide their national experience, propose changes and additions in case of discussion papers etc.
- **Discussion papers uploaded** on SharePoint, can be marked “just for internal discussion”; changes and comments will be tracked, limited time to deliver comments
- Finally, an **agreed or finally discussed document** will be **forwarded** to the COM
