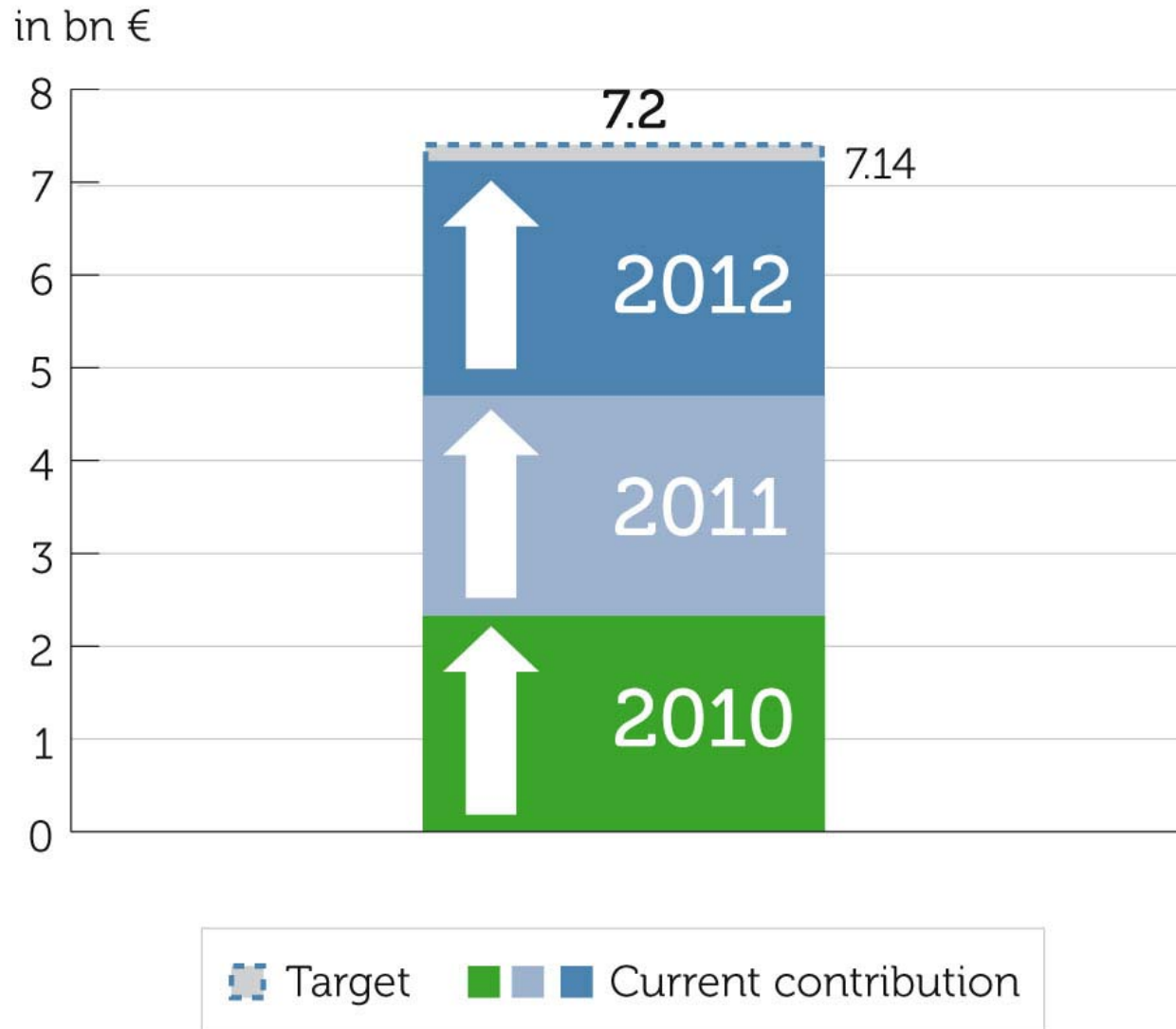

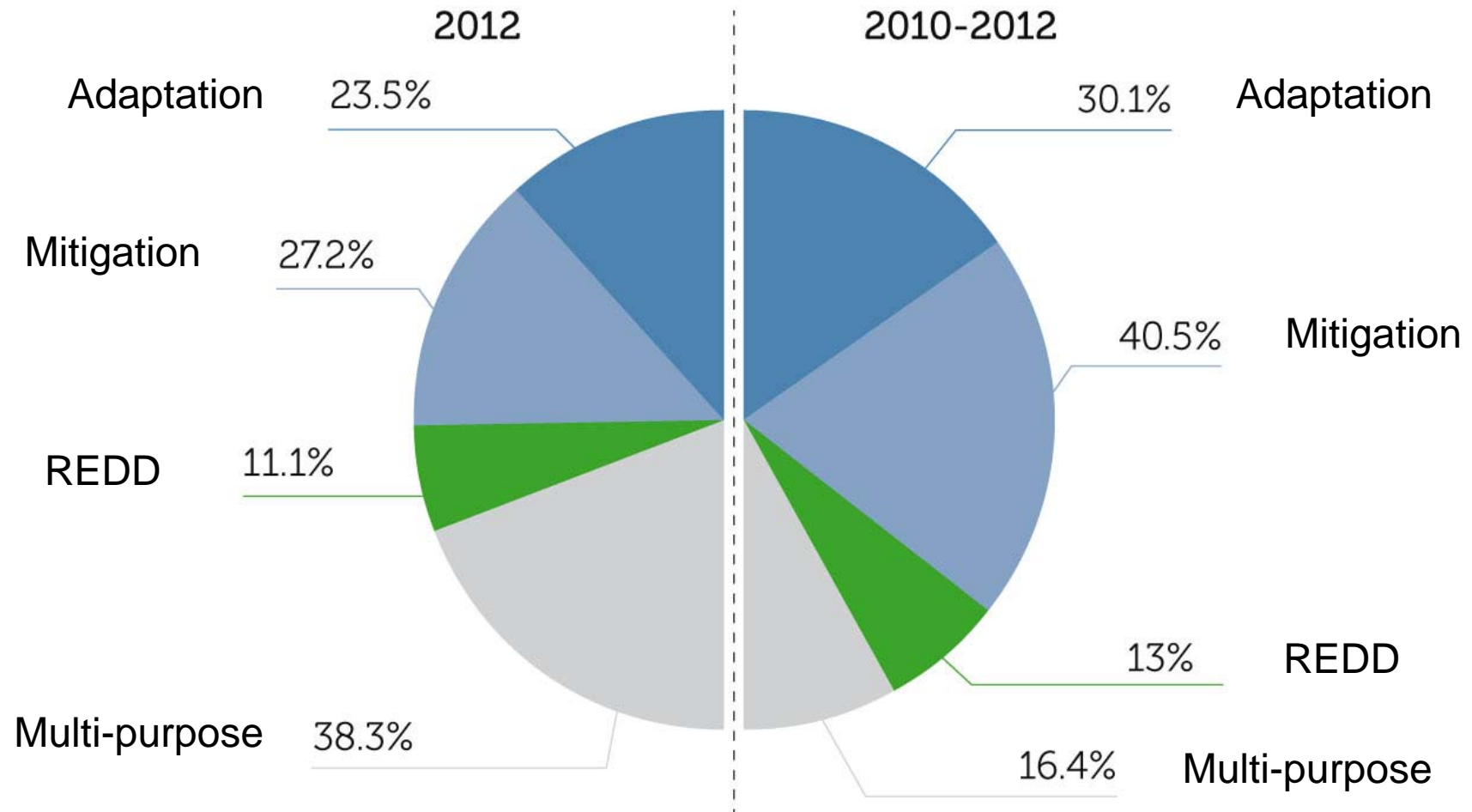

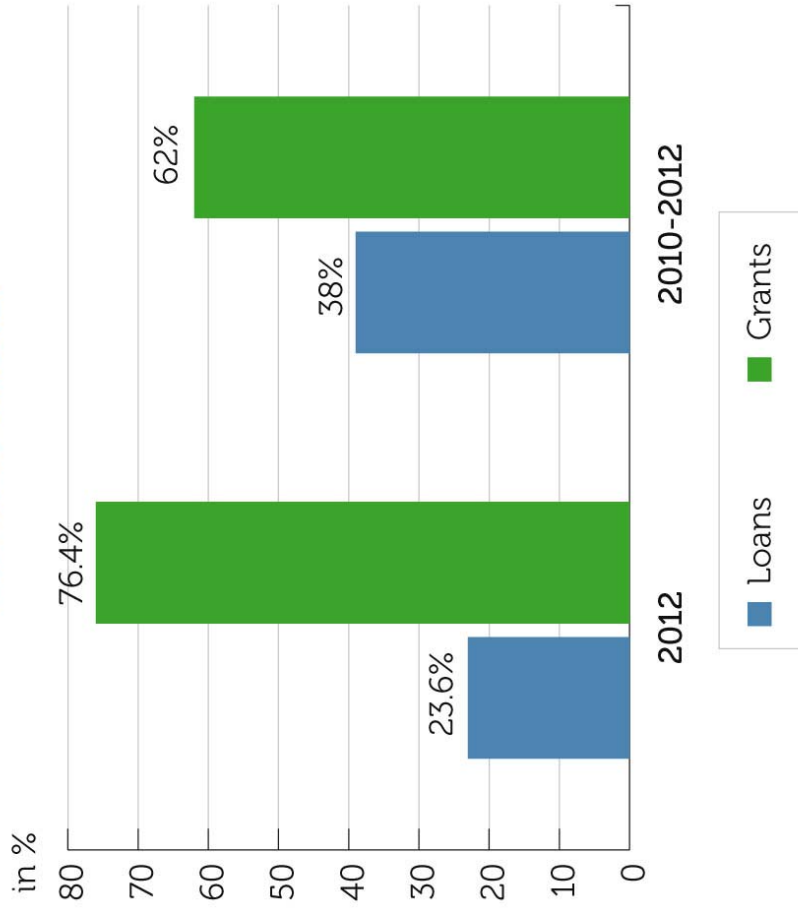
## EU's fast start contribution



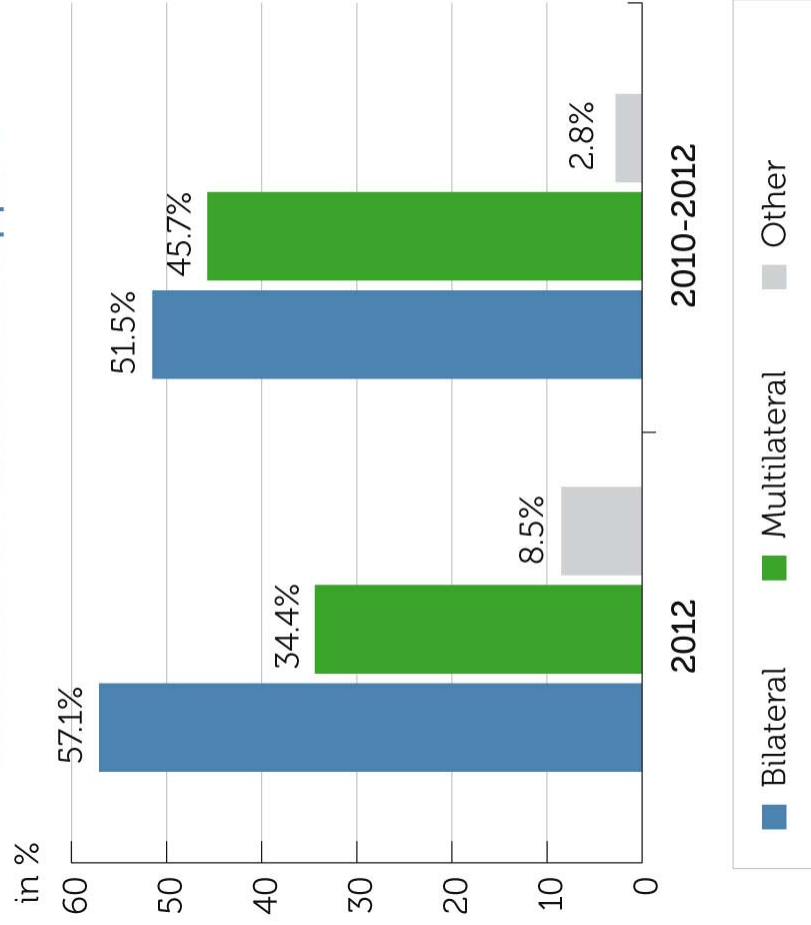
## Allocation of EU fast start funding

## How and where is the money spent?

- Continued commitment to full transparency:
  - Analytical summary report on EU fast-start finance
  - List of EU actions funded (possibility to query by donor, activity type, recipient, ...)
  - Brochure with concrete project examples in the areas of adaptation, mitigation and REDD+



## Next steps in EU fast-start reporting

- Provisional EU fast start finance report endorsed by EU Finance Ministers on 13 November 2012
- This report comprises data received until early November 2012, further EU fast-start actions are in the budgetary approval cycle and hence, not listed
- A full, consolidated report will be submitted to the UNFCCC Secretariat by May 2013
