


Respondents in Croatia remain concerned about climate change, and almost one in five identify this as the most serious problem facing the world (17%, close to the EU average of 15%). Nearly seven in ten respondents consider it a "very serious" problem (69%).

While respondents were less likely than average to say they had taken some action to fight climate change in the past six months (38%, compared to the EU average of 49%), when presented with a list of specific activities, the figure rose to 82%. Practical measures taken include:

- Trying to reduce waste and regularly separate it for recycling (52%, +6 percentage points since 2013)
- Trying to cut down consumption of disposable items whenever possible (47%, +9 percentage points since 2013)
- Buying locally produced and seasonal food whenever possible (40%)

A large majority (81%) agree that fighting climate change and using energy more efficiently can boost the economy and create jobs. Most respondents support national action to increase the use of renewable energy (93%) and improve energy efficiency by 2030 (91%). More than nine in ten (91%) respondents believe that fighting climate change will only be effective if all countries of the world act together.











QA3 In your opinion, who within the EU is responsible for tackling climate change? (MULTIPLE ANSWERS POSSIBLE)










QA4.1 To what extent do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements? Fighting climate change and using energy more efficiently can boost the economy and jobs in the EU (%)



QA4.2 To what extent do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements? Fighting climate change will only be effective if all countries of the world act together (%)


