### 1. COUNTRY HIGHLIGHTS


Nearly six in ten respondents in the Czech Republic consider climate change to be a 'very serious' problem (57%, EU average 74%), although less than one in ten see it as the single most serious problem facing the world (6%, EU average 12%).


Just under four in ten (38%, EU average 49%) say they have taken personal action to fight climate change in the past six months. However, when given specific examples this proportion rises to 92%, above the EU average of 90%. This suggests that many of those surveyed do not associate certain actions with tackling climate change.

- Seven in ten respondents in the Czech Republic (70%) say that they try to reduce waste and regularly separate it for recycling, very close to the EU average (71%).
- Nearly half try to cut down on consumption of disposable items whenever possible (47%, EU average 56%), a 7 percentage point decline since the previous survey in 2015.

Around two-thirds of respondents agree that fighting climate change and using energy more efficiently can boost the economy and jobs in the EU (65%, EU average 79%), while more than half agree that reducing fossil fuel imports from third countries can benefit the EU economically (54%, EU average 65%).





### 7. ATTITUDES TOWARDS REDUCING FOSSIL FUEL IMPORTS AND TRANSITION TO CLEAN ENERGIES






