- Concerns about:
 - Timing of accreditation, especially where accreditation for EU ETS is new
 - Reduced verifier capacity in Phase III compared to Phase II. The cost of accreditation

- Many common issues
- Additional issues!
 - Internal verification documentation
 - Accreditation witness audits
