ARTICLE 21





Article 21 Legal Basis

ETS Directive - Article 21

- Each year MS shall submit to the Commission a report on the application of the ETS Directive
- The report shall be drawn up on the basis of a questionnaire drafted by the Commission
- The Commission shall publish a report on the application of this Directive

Commission Implementing Decision 2014/166/EU amending Decision 2005/381/EC

- Questionnaire for ETS phase III
- Deadline for reporting: 30 June each year

A&V Related Questions (Section 6)

- Q 6.1: Numbers of accredited/certified verifiers (scope)
- Q 6.2: Application of information exchange requirements

Specific to installations:

- Q 6.3: CA conservative estimates
- Q 6.4: VRs reporting non-material misstatements, nonconformities, non-compliances (with the MRR), recommendations
- Q 6.5: CA Checks on AERs/VRs and Inspections
- Q 6.6 Waive of verifier site visits

Specific to aircraft operators:


Q 6.7 – Q 6.10: Equivalent to Q 6.3 – Q 6.6





Some initial facts / findings

Accredited verifiers per MS (shown for combustion and aviation)



In 6 States, a NAB has not applied for EA peer review

According to ETS CAs (AV TF, Compliance review project) enough verifier capacity was in place, so that verifier availability was not a bottleneck


In about half of the reporting States there are accredited verifiers for most of the scopes

In about half of the reporting States there are accredited verifiers only in some scopes





Accredited/Certified verifiers by a NAB in another country carrying out verification in country indicated



In 26 States foreign verifiers are performing verification activities

Crucial role played by the EA and the peer evaluation of NABs

Only in 3 MS has a NAB been requested by a NAB in another country to carry out surveillance on its behalf as per Art. 49 AVR





Examples of other Article 21 A&V findings (provisional data)

- 2 MS reporting administrative measures (4)
- 5 MS reporting complaints (33)
- 8 MS reporting conservative estimates (37 installations)
- 4 MS reporting rejection of verified AERs due to noncompliance with MRR (11)
- 11 States reporting site inspections (412)





MS COMPLIANCE REVIEW





Compliance Review Aims

Evaluation of the implementation of the 2013/2014 EU ETS compliance cycle at MS level

- Evaluation of MS compliance: MRR and AVR
- Analysis of MS-specific provisions

Analysis of results highlighting

Best practices

Shortcomings and inconsistencies amongst MS

Identification of requirements that MS find difficult to implement

Development of recommendations for improvement



Approach

Identification of key issues

MRR and AVR basis

Questionnaire development

Data collection through interviews

- Calibration interview
- In-country or by phone

Aggregation and analysis

Reporting and sharing of outcomes

- Main report: Overall findings (topic specific, all MS)
- Country-specific fiches (findings and recommendations)

Action



Overall Conclusions (unconfirmed)

MRR and AVR has resulted in clear improvements

- Harmonisation, e.g. regarding accreditation, uncertainty assessments and unreasonable costs
- Significant changes affecting ca. 50% of States

Variation in implementing practises reduced, but not completely

- Resourcing issues
- Misinterpretation of requirements, e.g. in the VR

General feedback that the MRVA system is working well, but non-compliances still being observed

Majority of States in favour of centralised support

Improvement Reports seen as a valuable addition to the Compliance Cycle (achieving further improvements)





A&V Conclusions (unconfirmed)

Changes due to the AVR markedly affected ca. 50% MS

Verification benefited by more formalised process

Sufficient NAB capacity and accredited verifiers (in time)

Cross-border accreditation important to a number of States

One MS NCA (with one 'certified' natural person verifier)

Information exchange working well but room for improvement re cross-border exchanges and timeliness

 NAB/NCA Work Programmes and Management Plans are not just required to go to the home CA

Support for verifier notification updates (improved data)

Support for good practice guidance re CA communications to NABs
