Strawman Proposal (I)

Developing document, the 3rd version released on 19 September

Goal: Climate Neutral Growth as of 2020

Baseline: 2018-2020 average

Scope: International flights

Participants: Aircraft operators





Strawman Proposal (II)

Range of options for distribution of the obligations on the table:

- Based on a ratio of individual growth rate and sectoral growth rate (50:50; 0:100)
- 2) Based on historical emissions
- 3) Based on route differentiation





Strawman Proposal (III)

Exemptions:

- 1. Services to and from Lowest Emissions States
- 2. Technical exemptions:
 - Aircraft operators with less than 10000 t of CO2 per year
 - 2. Humanitarian, military, fire fighting, etc...
 - 3. Aircraft with the 5700 MTOW





Strawman Proposal (IV)

Compliance tracking: an international registry

Emissions units: eligibility criteria to be developed

by the CAEP GMTF

MRV: to be developed by CAEP GMTF





CAEP GMTF:

- 1. Development of eligibility criteria for emissions units
- Development of recommendations for a MRV for a global MBM
- 3. Assessment of impacts of the Strawman





MRV for international aviation

- MRV task group created under the CAEP
 - Participation from EU, US, China, Singapore, industry & NGOs
- Task: development of the recommendations for MRV system for a global MBM:
 - Procedures for monitoring fuel consumption/emissions, reporting and verification procedures
 - Procedures for MRV of alternative fuels





Elements "pre-defined" in the Strawman:

- MRV carried on an annual basis
- Aircraft operators report to a single State (State that issued AOC)
- Monitoring and reporting of emissions is based on actual fuels consumed
- Simplified methods to small operators
- States report emissions of their operators to ICAO





Procedures for monitoring

- A number of methods under discussion:
 - Based on fuel purchase
 - Based on demonstrated fuel consumption
 - Based on estimation
- Differentiation of requirements for operators with different levels of activity
- Balance between accuracy and simplicity





Procedures on Reporting

Working papers under development:

- Reporting means and methods
- Data needs for verification, reporting and validation
- Transparency and confidentiality

- Attribution of aircraft operators to States
