Activities 2016

- Focused on collection and discussion of issues that cause difficulties in practical implementation and therefore might be recommended to include in a revision of the MRR
 - Prepared a template for use by the MS to explain an MRR issue and for comments by other MS
- Exchange of experiences with on-site inspections
- Discussion of practical MRR issues: examples on unreasonable costs for MR measures, issues on sampling practice for carbon black, correlation models used in the refinery industry and other activity specific issues raised by MS
