How to register in the Fgas Portal & HFC Licensing System

January 2023



Legal requirements

The F-Gas Portal & HFC Licencing System is set up in accordance with Article 17 of the F-Gas Regulation (EU) No 517/2014 and the Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/661 of 25 April 2019 ensuring the smooth functioning of the registry for quota for placing hydrofluorocarbons on the market. Non EU-companies should also pay attention to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/980 of 17 June 2021.



Import and export licensing requirements

Prior to carrying out any activities that fall under Regulation (EU) 517/2014 (EN) (the 'F-gas Regulation') the undertaking shall register in the F-gas Portal & HFC licensing system.

This is mandatory for companies to receive a quota, for importers of equipment containing HFCs, and for all entities supplying or receiving exempted gases such as those hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs) imported for destruction, for use as feedstock, directly exported in bulk, as well as for use in military equipment, in semiconductor manufacture or for metered dose inhalers (MDIs).


Provide the name and function of the person legally authorised to represent the undertaking

To finalise registration you need to prepare a statement confirming your intent to register. The statement must be printed on headed business paper and signed by a person who is a beneficial owner or an employee of the organisation and has the authority to make legally binding statements on behalf of your organisation. In authorising person is for example a general manager. Please give the name of the person who will sign the statement. FIRST NAME * FUNCTION *



A <u>non-EU company</u> has to

- provide an own unique EORI number
- 2. upload a relevant official document on which the name and legal form appears
- 3. upload a certified translation of that document in English
- 4. appoint an EU Only Representative, which is a company established in the EU for the purpose of compliance with the requirements of the F-Gas Regulation (EU) 517/2014
- N.B. The main user has to be an employee or beneficial owner of the EU Only Representative. Later other users can be added.





If you tick one of the consent boxes, your company will be registered in the « matchmaking tool ». It allows quota holders and companies seeking quota authorisations to find and contact each other. To be displayed, companies must give their consent.

	Verify if all fields in your registration form are completed correctly and download the statement confirming your intent to register. Next upload a signed copy. Note that if you change anything in your registration form then the information in the statement must also be updated. If you update the registration form you must download a new statement.

- 1. Fill in the authorising person's details.
- 2. 'DOWNLOAD' the registration form statement. The system generates it with the information you entered before.
- 3. Print the statement on headed business paper, have it dated and signed by a beneficial owner or employee of the organisation who is authorised to make legally binding statements on behalf of the organisation.
- 4. Scan and upload it to the system. It is important that the document is uploaded by the appointed account manager in order to be indicated as "main user" by the system.

Non-EU companies must have the statement dated and signed by the Only Representative also.




Customs authorities are not asked to provide a financial identification form.

Please download the financial identification form. Please fill in the form, date and sign it by the account holder, and have it stamped and signed by a representative of your bank. Please upload the completed copy. Note: In case of non-EU companies this form needs to be completed by the OR and signed by an EU-based bank. OWNLOAD FINANCIAL ID DOWNLOAD No file selected BROWSE UPLOAD

- 'DOWNLOAD' the financial identification form.
- 2. Fill in the form, have it dated and signed by the account holder (the bank account has to be in the Union and used by the undertaking for its business activities)
- 3. Have the form dated and signed by a representative of your bank (preferably) or include an original official bank statement covering a period within the last 3 months. In the latter case, the form and bank statement should be merged into a single document.
- 4. Scan and upload the form (with bank statement if applicable) to the system N.B. for non-EU companies: The EU Only Representative has to fill-in the financial identification form.





Once you have filled in the templates and uploaded both statements, please click on 'SUBMIT'.
